Odyssey Village

The Odyssey Village is a non-profit human development agency that provides substance abuse treatment and behavioral management in a variety of different settings. We meet the needs of women, men, families, couples, women with children, and men with children. Our holistic approach challenges the person to emerge as economically self-reliant, develop positive character, and become spiritually, physically, emotionally, and psychologically healthy while learning to live a lifestyle of recovery.

What We Do and Who We Help

Our program is based on the therapeutic community method of treatment. The therapeutic community represents a highly structured environment with defined boundaries, both moral and ethical. It employs community and peer-imposed consequences, as well as earned advancement of status and privileges as part of the recovery and growth process. Being a part of something greater than oneself is an especially important factor in facilitating positive growth. Our participants are culturally, economically, and politically unique, which is essential in the therapeutic community treatment process. Each person — no matter their race, ethnicity, gender, or economic background — brings their own unique value and experience to the Village.



Our Locations and Programs

Flint, Saginaw, and Port Huron Odyssey House drug and alcohol treatment programs operate as the foundation of the Odyssey Village's holistic and comprehensive recovery management service array. The Village recognizes addiction as a chronic problem that requires long-term relationships through a therapeutic community that extends beyond basic substance abuse treatment. Odyssey offers the following services:

Our Mission

Flint and Saginaw Odyssey Houses share an overall goal of indirectly preventing ten people from abusing drugs for every one person who is treated at the facility for substance abuse and/or co-occurring disorders. We strive for this by:

- » Interrupting intergenerational cycles of poverty, violence, criminality, and substance abuse
- » Returning residents back to families as productive members of society
- » Developing stable families
- » Building safe neighborhoods
- » Providing community education for a more productive society

Program costs are funded by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Behavior Health and Developmental Disabilities Administration Office of Recovery Oriented Systems of Care Region 10 PIHP, Mid-State Health Network, and commercial insurance.

Detox Center

For the addicted, the fear and the effects of withdrawal following an abrupt discontinuance of alcohol, opioids, or other addictive substances is often the barrier to learning how to live a clean and sober life. At Flint Odyssey House, we offer a comprehensive, compassionate approach to detox that addresses all aspects of physical, mental, and emotional health. We provide both clinically and medically monitored 24/7 care, utilizing over-the-counter medications and short-term use of prescriptions to help alleviate potentially dangerous side effects, as well as reduce cravings. As withdrawal symptoms begin, our staff provides guidance and support to keep clients comfortable. We also counsel and recommend the next-steps for sustained recovery. The length of stay will vary from two to five days based on medical necessity.

24/7 Detox Admissions

Detox admissions are conducted 24/7 at our Flint residential treatment center, where each person is individually evaluated for a specific course or treatment. We accept admissions for patients being discharged from medical centers, as well as people off the street desiring to detox and take the next steps toward recovery. We offer transportation services in certain circumstances with prior arrangement during the admission process.

Priority Populations for Admission for Treatment

- » Pregnant IV drug users
- » Pregnant women
- » IV drug users
- » Parenting or postpartum woman, and/or parents at risk of having children removed from the home



A medically supervised detox seeks to mitigate the symptoms of withdrawal. This makes breaking the **chain of addiction** as comfortable and pain free as possible.



Residential & Outpatient Treatment Programs

Flint Odyssey House Residential

Flint Odyssey House is a state-designated residential treatment facility that provides client-centered substance abuse and mental health treatment for men, women, couples, parenting women and men, and families. This therapeutic community uses treatment methods that are based on social learning theory blended with behavioral modification, cognitive restructuring, insight-orientated therapy, and collective recovery.

Core Residential Services

- » Develop an attitude for treatment engagement
- » Increase self-control, self-efficacy, and emotional stability and regulation
- » Build skills and promote improved self-reflection
- » Build confidence and competence in making decisions and meeting new challenges
- » Implement knowledge and skills in a new recovery lifestyle
- » Coordinate treatment with the legal system

Saginaw Odyssey House Residential

Odyssey's Saginaw location is a state-designated residential facility with women's specialty services that assist female priority populations. Populations of focus are pregnant women, women with children, and intravenous drug users.

The Saginaw Odyssey House follows the same therapeutic community concepts as the Flint Odyssey House, utilizing peer pressure for confronting negative behavior and promoting both positive insight and positive growth

Outpatient Services ~ Flint, Saginaw, Port Huron

Flint Odyssey House's intensive outpatient services are for people with substance use disorders (SUD) or dual diagnoses who do not require medical detoxification or 24-hour supervision. The program is designed to help establish supports, facilitate relapse management, and instill coping strategies. Our programs are alternatives to inpatient and residential treatment.

Core Outpatient Services

- » Intensive outpatient
- » Group therapy
- » Recovery coaching
- » Mental health support
- » Recovery housing
- » Day treatment
- » Individual counseling
- » Enhanced women's services
- » Adolescent program
- » Legal system coordination

Ancillary Programs

Rubicon Recovery Housing

Flint ~ Saginaw ~ Port Huron

Transitioning back into everyday life after facing addiction and SUDs can be overwhelming. Odyssey Village provides a number of safe, structured therapeutic recovery housing options that support a lifestyle of lasting recovery. Our governing principle is “self-help and mutual self-help,” where each resident assumes primary responsibility for their own recovery, as well as the recovery of their peers. Residents are offered up to twelve months of residential assistance.

The Enhanced Parenting Project

The Enhanced Parenting Project provides connection between those clients in residential substance abuse services and peer-supported case management and service navigation. This program not only helps the client, but it provides support and interventions for children and family members not living in the treatment center. It also aims to teach how to improve quality of life in areas of housing, employment, and child/parent/family relationships.

Enhanced Women’s Specialty Services

The Enhanced Women’s Specialty Services program is designed to help pregnant and parenting women who have SUDs get clean, cut back on their use, or learn how to manage their SUDs and mental health needs. The program facilitators will also assist clients with issues involving CPS.

Adolescent Program

Our adolescent substance abuse program is designed to address the drug use of Genesee County area teens between the ages of thirteen and seventeen. Components of the program include intensive outpatient, individual counseling, case management, peer recovery support services, and family support resources.

Flint STRIVE: Specialized Employment Services

STRIVE’s mission is to transform the lives of at-risk populations by providing support and training that lead to livable wage employment and societal re-integration through vocational training and viable wage employment direction.

Health Awareness Center

HAC serves to foster and embrace the concept of “holistic” programs, which address the health and human service needs of the community, including its youth and family units. HAC also has several ethnic enrichment and education programs.

Odyssey Village puts its heart in being a multi-disciplinary treatment center, offering a diverse array of programs that address the impacts of substance abuse, from treating the addicted to treating the family structure.
